Students are asked to keep an online website and a physical sketchbook during the course of the school year with assignments due approximately every 2 weeks. These assignments are meant to reinforce the topics covered in class. Bring your physical sketchbook to class every day.

ONLINE SKETCHBOOK

DOCUMENT

All projects should be documented on your website gallery in reverse chronological order (latest work added to the top).

REFLECTION/PROCESS

Write and post a reflection about your classroom projects (in process and finished) as well as what you have learned in class to the blog portion of your website.

PHYSICAL SKETCHBOOK

EXPLORATION

Students should create drawings and designs for class projects. These should be planning and/or thumbnail sketches.

AWARENESS

Students should pay attention to all professional print and digital media (posters, advertisements, menus, etc). For this assignment students paste photos of the designs or better yet, the actual objects in their sketchbooks. Students should then write a “reaction” (good and bad) with a focus on being curious, asking questions, and considering how their own design work might be influenced by what is seen.

Your sketchbook is a place for your private and honest thoughts and feelings. I want to encourage this in your writings and your art. However, if there is something you do NOT want me to see or read, please staple the pages shut or don't post online.
